Our Board Members are community leaders who set the direction and policies for the organization.

Responsibilities

- Actively support our mission, policies, and programs, helping to track our progress in reaching our long-term goals.
- Model our core values and be open to giving and receiving feedback.
- Participate in setting both the direction and policies of the organization.
- Provide appropriate guidance and support to co-CEOs.
- Attend monthly board meetings and participate in one committee or special project each year.
- Read and understand the organization's financial statements and help the board fulfill its fiduciary responsibilities to ensure that RLCFA is financially accountable and fiscally sound.
- Ensure legal and ethical integrity while maintaining accountability.
- Actively participate in RLCFA's giving campaign, including making an annual contribution (in dollars and/or time) that reflects a personally significant commitment to the organization.
- Attend activities and events sponsored by the organization whenever possible.
- Recruit and orient new board members and participate in board development activities.

Board Meetings

The Board of Directors meets monthly.

Time Commitment

The estimated time commitment for Board members is 3-6 hours quarterly. Board members are expected to attend at least 75% of all scheduled Board meetings, in addition to actively participating on at least one committee or special project.

Length of Term

Board members serve a term of three years renewable indefinitely if agreed upon by the individual, board, and co-CEOs.
